5	A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT REVISING NATIONAL GUARD REENLISTMENT OR EXTENSION
6	INCENTIVES LAWS; MAKING THE BONUS PAYMENT AFFORDED UNDER THE MONTANA NATIONAL
7	GUARD REENLISTMENT OR EXTENSION ACT OF 1981 A DISCRETIONARY INCENTIVE PAYMENT
8	SUBJECT TO ANNUAL DETERMINATIONS BY THE ADJUTANT GENERAL OF THE MONTANA NATIONAL
9	GUARD; AMENDING SECTIONS 10-1-803, 10-1-804, 10-1-805, AND 10-1-806, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN
10	IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
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14	Section 1. Section 10-1-803, MCA, is amended to read:
15	"10-1-803. Definitions. As used in this part, the following definitions apply:
16	(1) "Bonus" means the extension or reenlistment or extension incentive bonus provided by this part.
17	(2) "Extension" means the continuation of active national guard service with the Montana national guard.
18	(3) "Member" means any enlisted member of the Montana army or air national guard.
19	(4)(3) "Reenlistment" means a second or subsequent voluntary enrollment in the Montana national
20	guard.
21	(5) "Secretary" means a designee of the department of military affairs.
22	(4) "Service member" means any enlisted member of the Montana army or air national guard."
23	
24	Section 2. Section 10-1-804, MCA, is amended to read:
25	"10-1-804. Bonus. A member is entitled to receive a Subject to an annual determination made by the
26	adjutant general that a bonus provided under this part is needed in order to increase retention in the Montana
27	national guard and that sufficient funds have been appropriated for this purpose, a service member may be
28	granted a lump-sum bonus payment for each year of service for which the service member extends or reenlists
29	or extends. Upon a determination that the bonus is needed and based on the amount appropriated for that
30	purpose, the adjutant general shall set the amount to be paid. The bonus must be paid to each eligible service



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1	member within 60 days following the successful completion of a year of service for which the member extended
2	or reenlisted. The secretary shall set the amount of the bonus based on the appropriation for that purpose date
3	that the service member signed the reenlistment or extension contract."
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5	Section 3. Section 10-1-805, MCA, is amended to read:
6	"10-1-805. Eligibility. The Subject to the determination made by the adjutant general pursuant to
7	10-1-804, the bonus must be granted to a person service member who is eligible for reenlistment or extension
8	and who:
9	(1) <u>reenlists or</u> extends the <del>person's</del> <u>service member's</u> original enlistment <del>or reenlists</del> in the Montana
10	national guard;
11	(2) holds a rank commensurate with a unit vacancy in accordance with the national guard bureau's
12	policy;
13	(3) does not have 20 years of total service;
14	(4) is not a civil service employee in a full-time capacity with the national guard, including but not limited
15	to active duty for training or full-time training duty;
16	(5) is not eligible for any federally funded national guard bonus for the reenlistment or extension covered
17	by this part; and
18	(6) attends 90% of the scheduled drills and annual training in the year for which that the benefit is to be
19	paid."
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21	Section 4. Section 10-1-806, MCA, is amended to read:
22	"10-1-806. Administration. (1) The secretary department shall administer this part. The secretary
23	department shall maintain records and make rules adopt regulations pursuant to 10-1-105 necessary for its
24	administration.
25	(2) The secretary department shall determine the eligibility of service members to receive the bonus and
26	disburse a lump-sum bonus payment upon a determination of eligibility."
