4	A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT ALLOWING A STATE VETERANS' HOME TO ADMIT PARENTS OF
5	VETERANS WHO DIED WHILE SERVING; AMENDING SECTIONS 10-2-401 AND 10-2-403, MCA; AND
6	PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
9	
10	Section 1. Section 10-2-401, MCA, is amended to read:
11	"10-2-401. Location and function of homes persons admitted. (1) The institutions at Columbia
12	Falls, in eastern Montana, and in southwestern Montana are the Montana veterans' homes , and their<u>.</u>
13	(2) The primary function of a veterans' home is to provide a home and subsistence for veterans. The
14	department of public health and human services may also admit spouses or surviving spouses of veterans to the
15	homes other persons eligible under 10-2-403 if space allows."
16	
17	Section 2. Section 10-2-403, MCA, is amended to read:
18	"10-2-403. Eligibility for residence in home. (1) To be eligible for residence in a Montana veterans'
19	home under rules prescribed by the department of public health and human services, a person must be a veteran.
20	or the spouse or surviving spouse of a veteran, or the parent of a veteran who died while serving in the United
21	States armed forces.
22	(2) Consideration must also be given to:
23	(1) (a) the person's age;
24	(2) (b) the person's physical and mental status;
25	(3)(c) the person's ability or inability to locate suitable alternative accommodations;
26	(4)(d) the person's term of residence in Montana;
27	(5) (e) the person's gender as it relates to availability of appropriate living space;
28	(6)(f) the ability of the Montana veterans' home to meet the person's needs; and
29	(7)(g) other admission requirements established by the department."
