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10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
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12	Section 1. Section 46-18-243, MCA, is amended to read:
13	"46-18-243. Definitions. For purposes of 46-18-241 through 46-18-249, the following definitions apply:
14	(1) "Pecuniary loss" means:
15	(a) all special damages, but not general damages, substantiated by evidence in the record, that a person
16	could recover against the offender in a civil action arising out of the facts or events constituting the offender's
17	criminal activities, including without limitation out-of-pocket losses, such as medical expenses, loss of income,
18	$expenses\ reasonably\ incurred\ in\ obtaining\ ordinary\ and\ necessary\ services\ that\ the\ victim\ would\ have\ performed$
19	if not injured, expenses reasonably incurred in attending court proceedings related to the commission of the
20	offense, and reasonable expenses related to funeral and burial or crematory services;
21	(b) the full replacement cost of property taken, destroyed, harmed, or otherwise devalued as a result of
22	the offender's criminal conduct;
23	(c) future medical expenses that the victim can reasonably be expected to incur as a result of the
24	offender's criminal conduct, including the cost of psychological counseling, therapy, and treatment; and
25	(d) reasonable out-of-pocket expenses incurred by the victim in filing charges or in cooperating in the
26	investigation and prosecution of the offense.
27	(2) (a) "Victim" means:
28	(i) a person who suffers loss of property, bodily injury, or death as a result of:
29	(A) the commission of an offense;
30	(B) the good faith effort to prevent the commission of an offense; or

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ı	(C) the good faith effort to apprehend a person reasonably suspected of committing an offense,
2	(ii) the estate of a deceased or incapacitated victim or a member of the immediate family of a homicide
3	victim;
4	(iii) a governmental entity that:
5	(A) suffers loss of property as a result of the commission of an offense in this state or;
6	(B) that incurs costs or losses during the commission or investigation of an escape, as defined in
7	45-7-306, or during the apprehension or attempted apprehension of the escapee; or
8	(C) incurs costs or losses as result of extraditing an offender from an out-of-state jurisdiction to Montana
9	(iv) an insurer or surety with a right of subrogation to the extent it has reimbursed the victim of the offense
10	for pecuniary loss;
11	(v) the crime victims compensation and assistance program established under Title 53, chapter 9, par
12	1, to the extent that it has reimbursed a victim for pecuniary loss; and
13	(vi) any person or entity whom the offender has voluntarily agreed to reimburse as part of a voluntary plea
14	bargain.
15	(b) Victim does not include a person who is accountable for the crime or accountable for a crime arising
16	from the same transaction."
