8	A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT ESTABLISHING AN EASTERN MONTANA LABORATORY OF
9	CRIMINALISTICS IN YELLOWSTONE COUNTY; PROVIDING AN APPROPRIATION FOR CONSTRUCTION
10	OF THE LABORATORY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE."
11	
12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
13	
14	Section 1. Section 44-3-301, MCA, is amended to read:
15	"44-3-301. Laboratory of criminalistics. (1) There is a laboratory of criminalistics within the department
16	of justice. The laboratory's purpose is to perform analysis of specimens submitted by all Montana state, county,
17	or city law enforcement officers and all state agencies and referral specimens from other states if accepted by
18	the laboratory director.
19	(2) The laboratory's functions include analysis of toxicologic and criminalistic specimens which the
20	laboratory director considers within the performance capability of the laboratory.
21	(3) The laboratory must have a western Montana branch located in Missoula County and an eastern
22	Montana branch in Yellowstone County. Each branch must be capable of performing all purposes, duties, and
23	functions required by this part. The laboratory director will determine the purposes, duties, and functions
24	OF EACH BRANCH."
25	
26	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Transfer of funds. On July 1, 2015, the state treasurer shall transfer \$5.8
27	<u>\$2.05</u> million from the general fund to the long-range building program account in the capital projects fund type
28	provided for in 17-7-205.
29	
30	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Appropriations. (1) (a) There is appropriated \$5.8 \$2.05 million from the

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1	long-range building program account to the department of administration for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015,
2	for the construction of an eastern Montana branch of the laboratory of criminalistics in Yellowstone County.
3	(b) If the department of administration determines that leasing facilities for the laboratory would be more
4	appropriate, the department is authorized to spend up to \$340,000 (\$210,000) to secure appropriate leased
5	facilities for the biennium and the remainder of the appropriation in subsection (1)(a) reverts to the general fund.
6	(2) There is appropriated $\$1.8$ million $\$450,000$ from the general fund to the department of justice for the
7	biennium beginning July 1, 2015, to provide for personal services and operating expenses, including training and
8	initial operating expenses, of an eastern Montana branch of the laboratory of criminalistics in Yellowstone County.
9	Unspent funds revert to the general fund.
10	
11	NEW SECTION. Section 4. Legislative consent. The appropriation contained in [section 3] constitutes
12	legislative consent for the construction of an eastern Montana branch of the laboratory of criminalistics in
13	Yellowstone County within the meaning of 18-2-102.
14	
15	NEW SECTION. Section 5. Effective date. [This act] is effective July 1, 2015.
