| 9  | WHEREAS, the North Coast Hiawatha ceased operation through southern Montana in 1979, and                           |
| 0  | transportation to and from the major population centers of southern Montana would be greatly enhanced by           |
| 1  | passenger rail service; and  |
| 2  | WHEREAS, increased passenger rail services will increase railroad-related employment because of the                |
| 3  | need for upgraded rail infrastructure and operating personnel; and   |
| 4  | WHEREAS, tourism is Montana's second-largest industry and would be enhanced by improved                            |
| 5  | passenger rail service; and  |
| 6  | WHEREAS, the Empire Builder is one of the most popular long-distance passenger trains in the United                |
| 7  | States, and is greatly needed for the citizens of Montana's Hi-Line who have limited public transportation options |
| 8  | but is challenged by lack of rail capacity causing frequent delays; and  |
| 9  | WHEREAS, there is currently no board or commission within the state of Montana that is charged with                |
| 20 | the sole responsibility of overseeing and advocating for passenger rail service.                                   |

| 22 | NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE                               |
| 23 | STATE OF MONTANA:  |
| 24 | That the Legislative Council be requested to designate an appropriate interim committee, pursuant to               |
| 25 | section 5-5-217, MCA, or direct sufficient staff resources to investigate ways to improve passenger rail services  |
| 26 | in Montana, including but not limited to the establishment of a passenger rail commission.                         |
| 27 | BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that if the study is assigned to staff, any findings or conclusions be                     |
| 28 | presented to and reviewed by an appropriate committee designated by the Legislative Council.                       |
| 29 | BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all aspects of the study, including presentation and review                           |

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requirements, be concluded prior to September 15, 2016.

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1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the final results of the study, including any findings, conclusions,

2 comments, or recommendations of the appropriate committee, be reported to the 65th Legislature.
