| 9 | WHEREAS, the Miracle of America Museum, Inc., in Polson, Montana, was founded by Gil and Joanne |
| 10 | Mangles in 1981 as a nonprofit museum and was called by former governor Judy Martz a premier tourist |
| 11 | attraction; and |
| 12 | WHEREAS, the museum exhibits the largest collection of antique artifacts in Montana, including Native |
| 13 | American items, cars, toys, guns, clothing, wagons, snowmobiles, items as tiny as a bird-point arrowhead and |
| 14 | as large as the 65-foot "Paul Bunyan", the only remaining logging towboat used on Flathead Lake, and many |
| 15 | other items; and |
| 16 | WHEREAS, the museum is also home to the Montana Fiddlers Hall of Fame, is officially recognized as |
| 17 | the Montana DUI Victim Memorial, has a complete collection of official Montana state highway maps dating from |
| 18 | 1934, houses the largest collection in Montana of artifacts paying tribute to military veterans, has more than 3,000 |
| 19 | pieces of motorcycling memorabilia dating back to 1912, and is home to several items from Thomas Edison's |
| 20 | laboratory; and |
| 21 | WHEREAS, the museum is kid-friendly with many interactive displays that promote intergenerational |
| 22 | bonding; and |
| 23 | WHEREAS, the museum includes more than 40 buildings, many of which are historic to the area |
| 24 | including a 1912 schoolhouse and a fully equipped blacksmith shop; and |
| 25 | WHEREAS, the museum has been and continues to be an ideal place for schoolchildren to visit during |
| 26 | class field trips; and |
| 27 | WHEREAS, the museum is open all year and acts as a visitor center when the Polson chamber of |
| 28 | commerce is closed; and |
| 29 | WHEREAS, the museum has been called the Smithsonian of the West and has received accolades from |
| 30 | around the world. |
