8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10	Section 1. Section 81-6-104, MCA, is amended to read:
11	"81-6-104. Fee special fund. The county livestock protective committee may recommend to the board
12	of county commissioners the imposition of a fee in an amount not to exceed 50 cents \$1 per head on all cattle
13	9 months of age or older in the county on the regular assessment date of each year as provided in 15-24-903,
14	and the board of county commissioners shall impose the fee. The fee must be collected and deposited by the
15	county treasurer in a special fund to be known as the livestock special deputy fund, together with any other funds
16	made available from county, state, federal, or private sources for the purposes of this part."

18	Section 2. Section 81-6-204, MCA, is amended to read:
19	"81-6-204. Fee deposit of proceeds multiple-county district. The district cattle protective
20	committee may recommend to the board of county commissioners the imposition of a fee in an amount not to
21	exceed 50 cents \$1 per head on all cattle 9 months of age or older in the district on the regular assessment date
22	of each year as provided in 15-24-903, and the board of county commissioners shall impose the fee. The fee
23	must be collected and deposited in the county treasury of one of the counties in the district, selected by the district
24	cattle protective committee, in a special fund to be known as the livestock special deputy fund, together with any
25	other funds made available from county, state, federal, or private sources for the purposes of this part."

27	Section 3. Section 81-6-209, MCA, is amended to read:
28	"81-6-209. Fee deposit of proceeds single-county district. The district cattle protective committee
29	may recommend to the board of county commissioners the imposition of a fee in an amount not to exceed 50
30	cents <u>\$1</u> per head on all cattle 9 months of age or older in the district on the regular assessment date of each

1	year as provided in 15-24-903, and the board of county commissioners shall impose the fee. The fee must be
2	collected and deposited in the county treasury in a special fund to be known as the livestock special deputy fund,
3	together with any other funds made available from county, state, federal, or private sources for the purposes of
