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10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
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12	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Amendment of certificate of authority requirements. (1) A foreign
13	limited partnership may amend its certificate of authority to transact business by delivering to the secretary of
14	state for filing an amendment stating:
15	(a) the name of the foreign limited partnership;
16	(b) the date of filing of the foreign limited partnership's initial certificate; and
17	(c) the changes the amendment makes to the certificate of authority to transact business as most
18	recently amended.
19	(2) A foreign limited partnership shall promptly deliver to the secretary of state for filing an amendment
20	to a certificate of authority to transact business to reflect:
21	(a) the admission of a new general partner;
22	(b) the dissociation of a general partner; or
23	(c) the revision of any other information at any time for a proper purpose as determined by the foreign
24	limited partnership.
25	(3) A general partner that knows that any information in an application for registration as a foreign limited
26	partnership was false when filed or that any information in a certificate of authority to transact business has
27	become false due to changed circumstances shall promptly:
28	(a) cause the certificate to be amended; or
29	(b) if appropriate, deliver to the secretary of state for filing a statement of change pursuant to 35-7-110
30	or a statement of correction pursuant to 35-12-616.

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1	(4) Subject to 35-12-614(3), an amendment is effective when filed by the secretary of state.
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3	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
4	integral part of Title 35, chapter 12, part 13, and the provisions of Title 35, chapter 12, part 13, apply to [section
5	1].
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7	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval.
