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8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:							
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10	Section 1. Section 50-51-114, MCA, is amended to read:							
11	"50-51-114. Temporary emergency lodging program definitions. (1) There is a voluntary temporary							
12	emergency lodging program for licensed establishments located in Montana to assist designated charitable							
13	organizations in providing short-term lodging in Montana to individuals and families displaced from their							
14	residences.							
15	(2) Except as provided in subsection (8), participating establishments may receive a tax credit as							
16	provided in 15-30-2381 and 15-31-171 for providing temporary lodging to an individual or family who is:							
17	(a) displaced from the individual's residence because of temporary immediate danger to the individual							
18	posed by an assault, as described in 45-5-206, or potential assault by a partner or family member, as defined in							
19	45-5-206 in immediate need of crisis housing; and							
20	(b) referred to the establishment by a designated charitable organization.							
21	(3) Except as provided in subsection (8), establishments participating in the temporary emergency							
22	lodging program are eligible for a tax credit as provided in 15-30-2381 and 15-31-171 for up to 5 nights of lodging							
23	for each individual per calendar year.							
24	(4) Temporary emergency lodging provided under this section must be provided at no cost to the							
25	individual or the referring organization.							
26	(5) Participating establishments may offer lodging based on availability of rooms.							
27	(6) The department shall maintain a registry of designated charitable organizations and shall provide a							
28	list of approved organizations to establishments upon on request. The department shall seek comment from							
29	appropriate statewide nonprofit organizations that work with victims of disaster and domestic violence when							
30	developing and updating the registry.							

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	(7)	For the purp	oses of 5	0-51-115	and this	section,	"designated	charitable	organization"	means an
orgar	nization	n approved by	the depa	rtment to	make refe	errals for	temporary e	mergency	lodging.	

(8) The tax credit referred to in subsections (2) and (3) does not apply to the costs of providing lodging to an individual who is displaced by a major disaster declared by the president under 42 U.S.C. 5170 or 5191 and who receives financial assistance for temporary housing under 42 U.S.C. 5174."

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NEW SECTION. Section 2. Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval.

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<u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Section 3. Retroactive applicability.** [This act] applies retroactively, within the meaning of 1-2-109, to tax years beginning after December 31, 2014.
