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| 9 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA: |
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| 11 | NEW SECTION. Section 1. Contract for suicide aftercare. (1) For the biennium beginning July 1, |
| 12 | 2015, the department of public health and human services shall contract with a unit of the Montana university |
| 13 | system to provide information and support services to family members of individuals who complete suicide. |
| 14 | (2) The services must be provided by individuals who are licensed as or in training for licensure as a |
| 15 | mental health professional and who are trained in matters related to suicide, risk of suicide, and prevention of |
| 16 | suicide. Services must include but are not limited to: |
| 17 | (a) response by phone or in person to questions or requests for support from family members of |
| 18 | individuals who have completed suicide; |
| 19 | (b) preventive interventions for individuals who have not yet been referred to a community mental health |
| 20 | provider; and |
| 21 | (c) referral to a community mental health provider if appropriate. |
| 22 | (3) If services are provided by an individual who has not obtained licensure in a mental health profession, |
| 23 | the individual must be supervised by a licensed mental health professional in the individual's mental health |
| 24 | discipline. |
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| 26 | NEW SECTION. Section 2. Effective date. [This act] is effective July 1, 2015. |
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| 28 | NEW SECTION. Section 3. Termination. [This act] terminates June 30, 2017. |
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
