7	5-5-223 AND 5-5-227, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."
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9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
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11	Section 1. Section 5-5-223, MCA, is amended to read:
12	"5-5-223. Economic affairs interim committee. (1) The economic affairs interim committee has
13	administrative rule review, draft legislation review, program evaluation, and monitoring functions for the following
14	executive branch agencies and the entities attached to agencies for administrative purposes:
15	(a) department of agriculture;
16	(b) department of commerce;
17	(c) department of labor and industry;
18	(d) department of livestock;
19	(e) office of the state auditor and insurance commissioner;
20	(f) office of economic development;
21	(g) the state compensation insurance fund provided for in 39-71-2313, including the board of directors
22	of the state compensation insurance fund established in 2-15-1019; and
23	(h) the division of banking and financial institutions provided for in 32-1-211; and
24	(i) the division of the department of revenue that administers the Montana Alcoholic Beverage Code.
25	(2) The state compensation insurance fund shall annually provide to the committee a report on its budget
26	as approved by the state compensation insurance fund board of directors."
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28	Section 2. Section 5-5-227, MCA, is amended to read:
29	"5-5-227. Revenue and transportation interim committee powers and duties revenue
30	estimating and use of estimates. (1) The revenue and transportation interim committee has administrative rule
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review, draft legislation review, program evaluation, and monitoring functions for the state tax appeal board established in 2-15-1015 and for the department of revenue and the department of transportation, for and the entities attached to the departments for administrative purposes, except the division of the department of revenue that administers the Montana Alcoholic Beverage Code and for the state tax appeal board established in 2-15-1015.

- (2) (a) The committee must have prepared by December 1 for introduction during each regular session of the legislature in which a revenue bill is under consideration an estimate of the amount of revenue projected to be available for legislative appropriation.
- (b) The committee may prepare for introduction during a special session of the legislature in which a revenue bill or an appropriation bill is under consideration an estimate of the amount of projected revenue. The revenue estimate is considered a subject specified in the call of a special session under 5-3-101.
- (3) The committee's estimate, as introduced in the legislature, constitutes the legislature's current revenue estimate until amended or until final adoption of the estimate by both houses. It is intended that the legislature's estimates and the assumptions underlying the estimates will be used by all agencies with responsibilities for estimating revenue or costs, including the preparation of fiscal notes.
- (4) The legislative services division shall provide staff assistance to the committee. The committee may request the assistance of the staffs of the office of the legislative fiscal analyst, the legislative auditor, the department of revenue, and any other agency that has information regarding any of the tax or revenue bases of the state."

NEW SECTION. Section 3. Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval.

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
