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9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
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11	Section 1. Section 80-3-303, MCA, is amended to read:
12	"80-3-303. Powers and duties of department. (1) The department may:
13	(a) enter a premises at any reasonable time to inspect produce for condition, for grade, or for determining
14	compliance with the provisions of this part, or for compliance with the FDA Food Safety Modernization Act, 21
15	<u>U.S.C. 2201, et seq.;</u> and
16	(b) cooperate with and enter into agreements with governmental agencies of this state, agencies of other
17	states, agencies of the U.S. government, and private associations, in furtherance of this part.
18	(2) (a) The department shall adopt rules necessary for the efficient implementation of this part.
19	(b) The department may adopt by reference regulations adopted under the FDA Food Safety
20	Modernization Act, 21 U.S.C. 2201, et seq."
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22	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Saving clause. [This act] does not affect rights and duties that matured,
23	penalties that were incurred, or proceedings that were begun before [the effective date of this act].
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25	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Severability. If a part of [this act] is invalid, all valid parts that are severable
26	from the invalid part remain in effect. If a part of [this act] is invalid in one or more of its applications, the part
27	remains in effect in all valid applications that are severable from the invalid applications.
