3 (4) (a) The balance in the state special revenue fund may be no more than the total of the income 4 generated by licensing fees plus an equivalent amount from income generated by the death certificate fees 5 deposited under subsection (1).

- (b) Any amount of income generated by the death certificate fees that is greater than the amount in subsection (4)(a) must be deposited in the state general fund the state veterans' cemeteries account provided for in 10-2-603 for the purposes described in 10-2-603 upon certification by the department that additional funds are not needed for special circumstances as provided in 17-2-302(2).
- (5) In even-numbered calendar years, beginning in July 2016, the board shall report to the economic affairs interim committee the status of the special revenue account and fees charged as a funding source for the board. (Terminates June 30, 2017--sec. 6, Ch. 380, L. 2015.)"
