6	TIMELINES FOR DETERMINATIONS CONCERNING THE CONFORMITY OF THE FINAL PLAT; REQUIRING
7	NOTIFICATIONS CONCERNING THE DETERMINATION; AND AMENDING SECTION 76-3-611, MCA."

9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11	Section 1. Section 76-3-611, MCA, is amended to read:
12	"76-3-611. Review of final plat. (1) The governing body or the agent or agency designated by the
13	governing body shall examine each final subdivision plat and the governing body shall approve the plat only if:
14	(a) it conforms to the conditions of approval set forth on the preliminary plat and to the terms of this
15	chapter and regulations adopted pursuant to this chapter; and
16	(b) the county treasurer has certified that all real property taxes and special assessments assessed and
17	levied on the land to be subdivided have been paid.
18	(2) (a) The governing body may require that final subdivision plats and certificates of survey be reviewed
19	for errors and omissions in calculation or drafting by an examining land surveyor before recording with the county
20	clerk and recorder. When the survey data shown on the plat or certificate of survey meets the conditions pursuant
21	to this chapter, the examining land surveyor shall certify the compliance in a printed or stamped certificate on the
22	plat or certificate of survey. The certificate must be signed by the surveyor.
23	(b) A land surveyor may not act as an examining land surveyor in regard to a plat or certificate of survey
24	in which the surveyor has a financial or personal interest.
25	(3) (a) A final plat is considered to be received on the date of delivery to the governing body or the agent
26	or agency designated by the governing body when accompanied by the review fee submitted as provided in
27	<u>76-3-602.</u>
28	(b) Within 15 working days of receipt of a final plat, the governing body or the agent or agency
29	designated by the governing body shall determine whether the final plat conforms to the requirements of
30	subsection (1)(a) and shall notify the subdivider or, with the subdivider's written permission, the subdivider's agent

of that determination. If the governing body or its agent or agency determines that the final plat does not conform
to the requirements of subsection (1)(a), the governing body or its agent or agency shall identify the final plat's
defects in the notification.

- (c) If the governing body or its agent or agency determines that information in the application is not sufficient to allow for review of the proposed subdivision, the governing body or its agent or agency shall identify the insufficient information in its notification.
- (d) If the governing body determines that an examining land surveyor must review a final plat or certificate of survey pursuant to subsection (2)(a), the governing body or its agent or agency shall identify the requirement in its notification.
- (e) The time limits provided in subsection (3)(b) apply to each submission of the final plat until a determination is made that the application contains the required elements and sufficient information pursuant to subsection (1)(a) and the subdivider or the subdivider's agent is notified."
