11	Section 1. Section 20-5-210, MCA, is amended to read:
12	"20-5-210. Enforcement exhaustion of administrative remedies. (1) A person alleging a violation
13	of 20-5-207 through 20-5-210 may seek redress under any available law, either civil or criminal, after exhausting
14	all administrative remedies.
15	(2) Nothing in this section precludes a person from contacting law enforcement in relation to incidents
16	of bullying at any point in time."
