4	A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT SOLELY CREATING THE FELONY OFFENSE OF ASSAULT ON
5	A HEALTH CARE WORKER OR EMERGENCY RESPONDER; PROVIDING A PENALTY; AND PROVIDING
6	AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Assault on health care provider or emergency responder penalty
11	definitions. (1) A person commits the offense of assault on a health care provider or emergency responder
12	if, while a health care provider or emergency responder is performing professional duties, the person:
13	(a) purposely or knowingly causes bodily injury to the health care provider or emergency responder;
14	(b) negligently causes bodily injury to the health care provider or emergency responder with a weapon;
15	or
16	(c) purposely or knowingly causes the health care provider or emergency responder reasonable
17	apprehension of bodily injury.
18	(2) A person convicted of assault on a health care provider or emergency responder shall be fined an
19	amount not to exceed \$50,000 or be imprisoned for a term not to exceed 10 years, or both.
20	(3) As used in this section, the following definitions apply:
21	(a) "Emergency responder" has the meaning provided in 45-5-214.
22	(b) "Health care provider" has the meaning provided in 50-4-504.

24	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
25	integral part of Title 45, chapter 5, part 2, and the provisions of Title 45, chapter 5, part 2, apply to [section 1].

27	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval.
