11	11 "20-7-1310. Youth suicide Mental health awareness and suicide preve	ention training. (1) This	
12	12 section may be cited as the "Suicide "Mental Health Awareness and Suicide Prevention	on Training Act".	
13	13 (2) The office of public instruction shall provide guidance and technical assista	ance to Montana schools	
14	on youth suicide mental health awareness and suicide prevention training materials. All training materials offered		
15	must be approved by the office of public instruction, meet the standards for professional development in the state,		
16	and be periodically reviewed by a qualified person or committee for consistency with generally accepted principles		
17	of youth suicide mental health awareness and suicide prevention training.		
18	(3) The legislature recommends that youth suicide mental health awareness and suicide prevention		
19	training be made available annually to each employee of a school district and to staff of the office of public		
20	instruction who work directly with any students enrolled in Montana public schools. The training must be provided		
21	at no cost to the employee. The training may be offered through any method of training identified in subsection		
22	22 (4).		
23	23 (4) The legislature recommends that employees under subsection (3) take at	t least <del>2</del> <u>4</u> hours of <del>youth</del>
