10	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Repealer. The following section of the Montana Code Annotated is
11	repealed:
12	1-1-510. English as official and primary language of state and local governments.

14	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Notification to tribal governments. The secretary of state shall send a
15	copy of [this act] to each tribal government located on the seven Montana reservations and to the Little Shell
16	Chippewa tribe.

18	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval.
