8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Concealing identity during commission of offense against public
11	order. (1) A person commits the offense of concealing a person's identity during the commission of an offense
12	against public order if the person wears a mask, hood, or other device that covers, hides, or conceals a portion
13	of the person's face for the purpose of evading or escaping discovery, recognition, or identification while
14	committing an offense described in Title 45, chapter 8.
15	(2) A person convicted of a violation of subsection (1) is guilty of a felony and shall be fined an amount
16	not to exceed \$5,000 or be imprisoned in the state prison for a term not to exceed 5 years, or both.

18	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
19	integral part of Title 45, chapter 8, and the provisions of Title 45, chapter 8, apply to [section 1].

21	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval.
