(d) for five or fewer lots within a platted subdivision, the relocation of common boundaries;

(e) divisions made for the purpose of relocating a common boundary line between a single lot within a platted subdivision and adjoining land outside a platted subdivision. A restriction or requirement on the original platted lot or original unplatted parcel continues to apply to those areas.

(f) aggregation of parcels or lots when a certificate of survey or subdivision plat shows that the boundaries of the original parcels have been eliminated and the boundaries of a larger aggregate parcel are established. A restriction or requirement on the original platted lot or original unplatted parcel continues to apply to those areas.

(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (1):

(a) within a platted subdivision filed with the county clerk and recorder, a division, redesign, or rearrangement of lots that results in an increase in the number of lots or that redesigns or rearranges six or more lots must be reviewed and approved by the governing body before an amended plat may be filed with the county clerk and recorder;

(b) a change in use of the land exempted under subsection (1)(c) for anything other than agricultural purposes subjects the division to review under parts 5 and 6 of this chapter.

(3) (a) Subject to subsection (3)(b), a division of land may not be made under this section unless the county treasurer has certified that all real property taxes and special assessments assessed and levied on the land to be divided have been paid.

(b) (i) If a division of land includes centrally assessed property and the property taxes applicable to the division of land are not specifically identified in the tax assessment, the department of revenue shall prorate the taxes applicable to the land being divided on a reasonable basis. The owner of the centrally assessed property shall ensure that the prorated real property taxes and special assessments are paid on the land being sold before the division of land is made.

(ii) The county treasurer may accept the amount of the tax prorated pursuant to this subsection (3)(b) as a partial payment of the total tax that is due.

(4) The governing body may examine a division or aggregation of land to determine whether or not the requirements of this chapter apply to the division or aggregation and may establish reasonable fees, not to exceed \$200, for the examination.

(5)(a) A person who receives a division of land pursuant to subsection (1)(b) may not transfer or otherwise convey the division of land to a nonimmediate family member for a minimum of 2 years after the date of the division unless the person demonstrates to the

governing body a documented financial, medical, or other hardship requiring the sale or other conveyance of the division of land.

Each owner is only responsible for decommissioning requirements as defined in [section 3(4)(b)] based on the owner's percentage share of ownership in the unit that is retired. A payment may be established through a memorandum of understanding or legal settlement, including but not limited to an order by a utility or regulatory commission.

(b) Except as provided in subsection (4)(c), payment for decommissioning requirements as defined in [section 3(4)(b)] must be deposited in the coal country planning and grant program account established in [section 11(1)].

(c) Payments for decommissioning requirements representative of statewide cost shifts established in [section 3(4)(b)(iv)] must be deposited in the state general fund.

(5)(a) Prior to entering into an agreement as provided in this section, the governor and attorney general shall provide the public with a notice of the proposed agreement and shall provide opportunity to comment on the terms of an agreement.

(10) Except as provided in subsection (11), after a plan is approved, an owner of a coalfired generating unit shall pay for and implement remediation in accordance with applicable legal obligations and decommissioning requirements as defined in [section 3(4)(a)] at the coalfired generating unit based on a schedule agreed to by the department and owner. When implementation is complete, the owner shall provide proof to the department that the requirements have been met.

(11)(a) Within 60 days of [the effective date of this act], the department shall request that an entity certified as an exempt wholesale generator pursuant to 42 U.S.C. 16451 that owns a coal-fired generating unit that will shut down on or before July 1, 2022, submit a bond or other financial assurance in a sum determined by the department in accordance with subsection (12), conditioned upon the faithful remediation of the coal-fired generating unit.

(b) Within 60 days of a request by the department in accordance with subsection (11)(a), an entity certified as an exempt wholesale generator pursuant to 42 U.S.C. 16451 that owns a coal-fired generating unit that will shut down on or before July 1, 2022, shall submit a bond or other financial assurance payable to the state of Montana in a form acceptable by the department and in a sum determined by the department.

(c) If the coal-fired generating unit has more than one owner, the bond required in accordance with this subsection (11) must cover only the individual owner's share of remediation costs at the site where the coal-fired generating unit is located.

(12) In determining the amount of the bond or other financial assurance required in accordance with subsection (11), the department shall take into consideration:

(a) the character and nature of the site where the coal-

fired generating unit is located;

(b) the current and reasonably anticipated uses of the property where the unit is located;

(c) applicable legal obligations; and

(d) other information determined relevant by the department.

(13) If an entity certified as an exempt wholesale generator pursuant to 42 U.S.C. 16451 that owns a coal-fired generating unit that will shut down on or before July 1, 2022, fails to

submit a bond or other financial assurance acceptable to the department within the timeframe required by this section, the department may assess an administrative penalty of \$10,000 and an additional administrative penalty of \$10,000 for each day the failure to submit the bond or financial assurance continues. The penalty must be deposited in the coal-country planning and grant program account established in [section 11(1)].

(14) An entity certified as an exempt wholesale generator pursuant to 42 U.S.C. 16451 that owns a coal-fired generating unit that will shut down on or before July 1, 2022, may appeal the department's penalty assessment or the amount of the bond or other financial assurance determined by the department to the board of environmental review within 20 days after receipt of written notice of the penalty or bond amount. The contested case provisions of the Montana Administrative Procedures Act, Title 2, chapter 4, part 6, apply to a hearing before the board under this subsection.

(15) The department shall release the bond or other financial assurance held in accordance with this section if it is satisfied that the owner's share of cleanup at the site where the coal-fired generating unit is located is complete.

(16) If an entity certified as an exempt wholesale generator pursuant to 42 U.S.C. 16451 that owns a coal-fired generating unit that will shut down on or before July 1, 2022, fails to attain a satisfactory degree of cleanup at the site where the unit is located and has not commenced action to rectify deficiencies within 30 days after notification by the department, the department shall cause the bond or other financial assurance to be forfeited." **Renumber:** subsequent subsection

(2) (a) Funding for each element of the decommissioning requirements must be made available for the purposes of subsections (1)(a) and (1)(b) in substantially the same amount as

identified in a plan approved by the department pursuant to [section 7]. Funding for decommissioning requirements as defined in [section 3(4)(b)(i)] must be provided to an eligible entity for potential distribution to residential and commercial real estate owners.

(b) If the funding available is less than the sum total of the decommissioning requirements identified in a plan and approved by the department, the funding available for each element of the decommissioning requirements must be determined by the department based on the ratio of available funds divided by the sum total of decommissioning requirements, multiplied by each element of the decommissioning requirements.

(c) If an agreement reached pursuant to [section 5] includes a payment but does not specify funding for each element of the decommissioning requirements, the governor and attorney general shall submit a statement allocating the funds. That statement is binding guidance to the department.

(3) For the purposes of subsection (1)(b), the department must receive proposals for grants from eligible entities. Eligible entities may work cooperatively on a proposal. The department shall work with applicants in preparing cost estimates for a proposal. In reviewing proposals, the department may consult with other state agencies with expertise pertinent to the proposal and use information included in an approved remediation and retirement plan.

(4) (a) The department shall adopt rules necessary to implement the planning and grant program in accordance with [section 6] and this section. In adopting rules, the department shall look to the rules adopted for programs administered by the coal board in accordance with Title 90, chapter 6, part 2, and other similar state programs. To the extent feasible, the department shall make the rules compatible with those other programs.

(b) The rules must provide for distribution methods for financial assistance.

(5) Administrative expenses for the grant program during a fiscal year may not exceed actual administrative costs, or 4% of the combined highest balances in the retirement planning and grant program accounts established in [section 11] in that fiscal year, whichever is less.

(6) The department shall report to the governor and the legislature as provided in 5-11-210 regarding the disbursement of funds and grants that are awarded during each biennium.
