9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11	Section 1. Section 20-1-301, MCA, is amended to read:
12	"20-1-301. School fiscal year. (1) The school fiscal year begins on July 1 and ends on June 30. At least
13	the minimum aggregate hours defined required in subsection (2) must be conducted during each school fisc
14	year, except that 1,050 aggregate hours of pupil instruction for graduating seniors may be sufficient. The
15	minimum aggregate hours required in subsection (2) are not required for any pupil demonstrating proficience
16	pursuant to 20-9-311(4)(d).
17	(2) The minimum aggregate hours required by grade are:
18	(a) 360 hours for a half-time kindergarten program or 720 hours for a full-time kindergarten program, a
19	provided in 20-7-117;
20	(b) 720 hours for grades 1 through 3; and
21	(c) 1,080 hours for grades 4 through 12.
22	(3) For any elementary or high school district that fails to provide for at least the minimum aggregate
23	hours, as listed in subsections (1) and (2), to any pupil not demonstrating proficiency pursuant to 20-9-311(4)(d
24	the superintendent of public instruction shall reduce the direct state aid for the district for that school year by two
25	times an hourly rate, as calculated by the office of public instruction, for the aggregate hours missed by each pure
26	not demonstrating proficiency pursuant to 20-9-311(4)(d)."
