4	A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT AUTHORIZING SUBMERGED SPEAR FISHING OF GAME FISH
5	FOR RECREATIONAL PURPOSES; PROVIDING RULEMAKING AUTHORITY; AMENDING SECTION 87-3-204,
6	MCA; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10	Section 1. Section 87-3-204, MCA, is amended to read:
11	"87-3-204. Designation of state waters for particular fishing methods. (1) (a) The Except as
12	provided in subsection (2), the commission may designate waters within the state in which rubber or
13	spring-propelled spears employed by persons swimming or submerged in the water or traps, seines, nets, spears,
14	or gigs may be used for taking:
15	(i) nongame fish; or
16	(ii) walleyed pike, sauger, northern pike, burbot (ling), and whitefish.
17	(b) The commission may adopt rules for the taking of fish under this subsection (1), and the rules may
18	be specific to the water designated. The designated waters may be closed at the discretion of the commission.
19	(c) Except when the taking of game fish is authorized pursuant to subsection (1)(a)(ii), all game fish
20	captured while fishing as authorized under this subsection (1) must be returned uninjured to the waters from
21	which they were taken.
22	(2) (a) Except as provided in subsection (2)(c), a person who, for recreational purposes, is swimming
23	or submerged in a lake or reservoir may take game fish with a spear as long as the person is fully submerged
24	and takes the game fish in accordance with any other laws or regulations in effect. A spear attached to a spear
25	gun must be attached with a lanyard that is not more than 20 feet in length.
26	(b) When a person is spear fishing pursuant to this subsection (2), a diver's flag, red with a white slash,
27	must be displayed on the water above the angler.
28	(c) A person spear fishing pursuant to this subsection (2) may not:
29	(i) use artificial light;
30	(ii) spear fish within 100 yards of a designated swimming or water ski area, boat dock, ramp, or spillway;

2	(iii) spear fish in waters restricted by the commission to only catch-and-release fishing.
3	(d) The commission may, on request, consider opening other waters or portions of waters to spear
4	fishing pursuant to this subsection (2) as long as the method is feasible and safe.
5	(2)(3) The commission may designate certain waters where setlines may be used to fish for certain
6	species of game or nongame fish, and the commission may designate the number of hooks and lines and the
7	length of line or lines that may be used as setlines.
8	(3)(4) The commission may designate waters where authorized commercial fishing operators may use
9	approved nets, seines, and traps to fish for designated species of nongame fish."
