8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10	Section 1. Section 20-4-102, MCA, is amended to read:
11	"20-4-102. Board of public education policies. To effect an orderly and uniform system of teacher and
12	specialist certification, the board of public education shall, upon the recommendation of the superintendent of
13	public instruction and in accordance with the provisions of this title, prescribe and adopt policies for the issuance
14	of teacher or specialist certificates. Such The policies shall must provide for:
15	(1) reasonable training and experience requirements for teacher, specialist, supervisor, and
16	administrative certificates and endorsements thereon as provided by the certification classification in 20-4-106
17	(2) procedures to expedite the issuance of a teacher, specialist, supervisor, or administrative certificate
18	to a person:
19	(a) who holds or has held a similar certificate or license in another state; and
20	(b) whose spouse is the subject of a military transfer to Montana;
21	(2)(3) the renewal of teacher or specialist certificates based on the same conditions prescribed for the
22	initial issuance of certificates;
23	(3)(4) the conduct of hearings on teacher or specialist certification revocation, suspension, or denial;
24	(4)(5) the issuance of emergency authorization to a district to employ a person who is not the holder of
25	a valid teacher certificate as an instructor of pupils; and
26	(5)(6) any other policy, not inconsistent with the law, which that is necessary for the proper operation of
27	a system of teacher and specialist certification."
