10	0 WHEREAS, Brucella abortus is listed as a potential bioterrorist agent or "select agent" by t	the United
11	1 States Department of Agriculture and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention; and	
12	2 WHEREAS, while other strains of Brucella are highly pathogenic, Brucella abortus rarely infec	t s humans
13	3 and is easily treated; and	
14	4 WHEREAS, in order to eradicate Brucella abortus in cattle and domestic bison, a vaccine	e must be
15	5 developed that is effective, but because research on select agents is highly regulated and requi	res costly
16	6 investments in secure infrastructure, the number of facilities that are able to perform research on the	pathogen
17	7 in large animals has been greatly reduced; and	
18	8 WHEREAS, because Brucella abortus is listed as a select agent it cannot be brought insi	de for the
19	9 studies that could lead to an effective vaccine, which is an absurd situation for veterinary research facil	ities in the
20	0 region.

22	2 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVE	SOFTHE
23	3 STATE OF MONTANA:	
24	4 That the United States Department of Agriculture's Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service	ce and the
25	5 Centers for Disease Control and Prevention:	
26	6 (1) reconsider the appropriateness of listing Brucella abortus as a select agent;	
27	7 (2) focus bioterrorism regulations on the Brucella pathogens that pose the greatest risk to hu	mans; and
28	(3) facilitate research into the transmission of the pathogen to cattle and domestic bison by promoting	
29	research to develop an effective vaccine and delivery system.	
30	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary of State send a copy of this resolution to the dire
