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| 9 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA: |
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| 11 | Section 1. Section 37-3-305, MCA, is amended to read: |
| 12 | "37-3-305. Qualifications for licensure. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), the board shall grant |
| 13 | a physician's license to practice medicine in this state to an applicant who: |
| 14 | (a) is of good moral character as determined by the board; |
| 15 | (b) is a graduate of an approved medical school as defined in 37-3-102; |
| 16 | (c) has completed an approved residency program or, for an applicant who graduated from medical |
| 17 | school prior to 2000, has had experience or training that the board has determined is at least the equivalent of |
| 18 | an approved residency program; |
| 19 | (d) has passed all of the steps of the United States medical licensing examination, the federation of state |
| 20 | medical boards' federation licensing examination, or an examination offered by any of the following entities: |
| 21 | (i) the national board of medical examiners or its successors; |
| 22 | (ii) the national board of osteopathic medical examiners or its successors; |
| 23 | (iii) the medical council of Canada or its successors if the applicant is a graduate of a Canadian medical |
| 24 | school approved by the medical council of Canada or its successors; or |
| 25 | (iv) the educational commission for foreign medical graduates or its successors if the applicant is a |
| 26 | graduate of a foreign medical school outside of the United States and Canada; |
| 27 | (e) has submitted a completed application with the required nonrefundable fee; and |
| 28 | (f) is able to communicate in the English language as determined by the board. |
| 29 | (2) The board may authorize the department to issue the license subject to terms of probation or other |
| 30 | conditions or limitations set by the board or may refuse a license if the applicant has committed unprofessional |

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| (3) A physician applying for expedited licensure in another state as allowed under 37-3-356 shall submit |
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| fingerprints to the board to facilitate a fingerprint-based criminal record background check by the Montana |
| department of justice and the federal bureau of investigation. The board may not disseminate criminal history |
| record information resulting from the background check across state lines. |

(3)(4) The board may by rule impose additional requirements for licensure to protect the health and safety of the public or to enter into a mutual recognition licensing agreement with another state.

(4)(5) The board may adopt rules that provide conditions for short-term nondisciplinary licenses."
