10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

12	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Article VIII of The Constitution of the State of Montana is amended by			
13	adding a new section 18 that reads:			
14	Section 18. Voter approval required for employer contribution increase in public retirement			
15	systems. (1) Any increase in public employer contributions for any public retirement system must be proposed			
16	by legislative referendum and approved by a majority of voters in an election.			
17	(2) Subsection (1) does not apply to a one-time-only appropriation by the legislature or supplemental			
18	state contributions to the retirement system.

20	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Two-thirds vote required. Because [section 1] is a legislative proposal			
21	to amend the constitution, Article XIV, section 8, of the Montana constitution requires an affirmative roll call vote			
22	of two-thirds of all members of the legislature, whether one or more bodies, for passage.

24	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Effective date. [This act] is effective upon approval by the electorate.

26	NEW SECTION. Section 4. Submission to electorate. [This act] shall be submitted to the qualified			
27	electors of Montana at the general election to be held in November 2018 by printing on the ballot the full title of			
28	[this act] and the following:
