4	A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT PROVIDING AN ACADEMIC BREWER LICENSE UNDER THE
5	SMALL BREWER EXCEPTION FOR A BREWER LICENSE; PROVIDING RULEMAKING AUTHORITY; AND
6	PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
9	
10	<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Section 1. Academic brewer license under small brewer exception conditions.
11	(1) A unit of the Montana university system or a community college may apply for an academic brewer license
12	under this section that meets the requirements of 16-3-214 with a small brewery exception, as provided for in
13	16-3-213, for a facility operated in conjunction with a beer-brewing class or curriculum taught at the Montana
14	university system unit or community college.
15	(2) When the unit of the university system or the community college has met the conditions in subsection
16	(3) and has paid the fee specified for a brewer under 16-4-501, the department shall issue the academic brewer
17	license.
18	(3) To obtain a license under this section, the applicant shall:
19	(a) document approval by the community college district board of trustees or the board of regents of
20	higher education, as applicable;
21	(b) identify the on-campus location of the site where classes in beer making are to be held and detail the
22	seating capacity for a sample room, if one is to be provided; and
23	(c) for criminal background requirements under 16-4-414, designate two or more individuals, each of
24	whom must have responsibility for licensing compliance and each of whom must meet the requirements in
25	16-4-401(2)(a).
26	(4) An academic brewer license is under the ownership of the unit of the Montana university system or
27	community college and is:
28	(a) to operate under the small brewery exception described in 16-3-213;
29	(b) not subject to quotas under 16-4-105 or to the provisions of 16-3-306; and
30	(c) not able to offer gambling activities.

1	(5) The department may adopt rules to implement this section.

3	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
4	integral part of Title 16, chapter 3, and the provisions of Title 16, chapter 3, apply to [section 1].
