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8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
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10	NEW SECTION. Section 1. False statement on employment application or questionnaire
11	definition. (1) A false statement made by an employee in either an employment application or an
12	employer-provided $\underline{\text{WRITTEN}}$ questionnaire calling for the disclosure of an employee's medical condition $\underline{\text{THAT IS}}$
13	RELEVANT TO THE ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS OF THE JOB following an A CONDITIONAL offer of employment, in a case in
14	which the medical condition affects the essential functions of the employee's job, bars all wage-loss or medical
15	benefits under this chapter if all of the following conditions are met:
16	(a) the employee knowingly or willfully, by omission or commission, makes a false representation
17	regarding the employee's physical condition THAT IS RELEVANT TO THE ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS OF THE JOB;
18	(b) the employer relies on the false representation and that reliance is a contributing factor in the hiring
19	of the employee; and
20	(c) there is a causal connection between the false representation FALSELY REPRESENTED CONDITION and
21	the injury OR OCCUPATIONAL DISEASE for which wage-loss or medical benefits are claimed.
22	(2) The employee has the right to petition the workers' compensation court AFTER SATISFYING THE
23	MEDIATION REQUIREMENTS OF THIS CHAPTER if the employee disagrees with a decision to terminate benefits or bar
24	benefits as provided under subsection (1).
25	(3) As used in this section, the term "essential functions of the employee's job" means the basic job
26	duties that an employee is required to perform, with or without reasonable accommodation.

29	integral part of Title 39, chapter 71, part 1, and the provisions of Title 39, chapter 71, part 1, apply to [section 1].
