9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
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11	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Use of waiver funding. (1) The department shall use money appropriated
12	for home and community-based services waiver slots for the purpose of:
13	(a) creating waiver slots as authorized by the legislature; or
14	(b) addressing workforce shortages or other barriers to creating the number of waiver slots authorized
15	by the legislature.
16	(2) Unencumbered funds appropriated for home and community-based services waiver slots for use by
17	a particular division may not be transferred to another department division or program. The money must be used
18	for the program for which it was appropriated or be reverted to the fund from which it was appropriated.
19	(3) The department shall report annually to the legislative finance committee on the status of
20	appropriations for home and community-based services waiver slots.

22	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Direction to department of public health and human services. The
23	LEGISLATURE DIRECTS THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES TO SUBMIT TO THE CENTERS FOR
24	MEDICARE AND MEDICAID SERVICES, BY NO LATER THAN SEPTEMBER 30, 2017, A REQUEST FOR AN AMENDMENT TO THE
25	MEDICAID HOME AND COMMUNITY-BASED SERVICES 0208 WAIVER FOR INDIVIDUALS WITH DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES
26	THAT:
27	(1) ALLOWS INDIVIDUALS AND PROVIDERS TO USE THE ENTIRETY OF EACH INDIVIDUAL'S COST PLAN TO PROVIDE
28	SERVICES THAT THE INDIVIDUAL NEEDS TO BE SUCCESSFUL IN THE COMMUNITY, NOT TO EXCEED THE AMOUNT OF MEDICAID
29	WAIVER APPROPRIATIONS IN HOUSE BILL No. 2;
30	(2) PROVIDES THE FLEXIBILITY NECESSARY TO ENABLE THE PROVISION OF PROFESSIONAL SERVICES TO AN

2	(3) PROVIDES A SUFFICIENT NUMBER OF EMERGENCY SLOTS THROUGHOUT MONTANA TO ACCOMMODATE
3	INDIVIDUALS WHO MAY GO INTO CRISIS.

5	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
6	integral part of Title 53, chapter 6, part 4, and the provisions of Title 53, chapter 6, part 4, apply to [section 1].

8	NEW SECTION. Section 4. Effective date. [This act] is effective July 1, 2017.
