| 15 | provided in subsection (2), whenever, by virtue of the provisions of any contract or obligation in the nature of a |
| 16 | contract made and entered into at any time after July 1, 1971, one party to the contract or obligation has an |
| 17 | express right to recover attorney fees from any other party to the contract or obligation in the event the party |
| 18 | having that right brings an action upon the contract or obligation, then in any action on the contract or obligation |
| 19 | all parties to the contract or obligation are considered to have the same right to recover attorney fees and the |
| 20 | prevailing party in any action, whether by virtue of the express contractual right or by virtue of this section, is |
| 21 | entitled to recover reasonable attorney fees from the losing party or parties. |
| 22 | (2) For a contract or obligation negotiated between a private party and a party with condemnation |
