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8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
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10	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Legal protections in relation to employing individuals with criminal
11	records. A private employer may not be held liable regarding claims of negligent hiring or negligent employment
12	for acts committed by an employee with a criminal record if the acts are committed outside the scope of the
13	employment and:
14	(1) the employer reviewed an arrest record prior to hiring that did not show a disposition of the case or
15	that indicated an acquittal or a dismissal;
16	(2) the conviction was for:
17	(a) a misdemeanor offense; or
18	(b) an offense that was not related to the employment; or
19	(3) the employee with a criminal record is under the supervision of the probation and parole division of
20	the department of corrections and the employment has been approved by the supervising officer.
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22	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
23	integral part of Title 39, chapter 2, and the provisions of Title 39, chapter 2, apply to [section 1].
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25	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Effective date applicability. [This act] is effective July 1, 2017, and
26	applies to individuals with criminal records acquired on or after July 1, 2017.
