9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11	Section 1. Section 7-14-2134, MCA, is amended to read:
12	"7-14-2134. Removal of highway encroachment. (1) Except as clarified in 23-2-312 and 23-2-313 and
13	except as provided in subsection subsections (4) and (5) of this section, if any highway is encroached upon by
14	a locked gate, fence, building, other manmade barrier, or otherwise, the road supervisor or county surveyor of
15	the district must shall give notice, orally or in writing, requiring the encroachment to be removed from the highway
16	(2) If the encroachment obstructs and prevents the use of the highway for vehicles, the road superviso
17	or county surveyor shall immediately remove the encroachment.
18	(3) The board of county commissioners may at any time order the road supervisor or county surveyo
19	to immediately remove any encroachment.
20	(4) This section does not apply to a fence for livestock control or property management that is in a county
21	road right-of-way and that is attached to or abuts a county road bridge edge, guardrail, or abutment if the fence
22	and bridge appurtenances are not on the roadway, as defined in 61-1-101. Any fence described in this subsection
23	must comply with 23-2-313.
24	(5) A county may issue a revocable permit for an encroachment upon a county road right-of-way as long
25	as the encroachment does not obstruct a road or create a hazard to traffic. An encroachment permit may no
26	allow a locked gate to be placed across a county road right-of-way."

28	Section 2. Section 7-14-2136, MCA, is amended to read:
29	"7-14-2136. Penalty for failure to remove encroachment promptly. If the encroachment is no
30	removed immediately or removal is not diligently conducted, the one who causes, owns, or controls the

1 encroachment is liable to for a penalty of \$10 up to \$250 for each day the same continues the responsible party

2 fails to remove the encroachment."
