4	A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF
5	MONTANA URGING CONGRESS TO PROPOSE THE REGULATION FREEDOM AMENDMENT TO THE
6	UNITED STATES CONSTITUTION.

8	WHEREAS, the growth and abuse of federal regulatory authority threaten our constitutional liberties,
9	including those guaranteed by the Bill of Rights in the First, Second, Fourth, and Fifth Amendments of our
10	Constitution; and
11	WHEREAS, federal regulators must be more accountable to elected representatives of the people and
12	not immune from such accountability; and
13	WHEREAS, the Declaration of Independence decried the imposition by the central government of "an
14	absolute tyranny over these states" and a central government that "erected a multitude of new offices and sent
15	hither swarms of officers to harass our people and eat out their substance"; and
16	WHEREAS, states too often find themselves in a similar position today; and
17	WHEREAS, the United States House of Representatives has passed with bipartisan support the REINS
18	Act to require that Congress approve major new federal regulations before they can take effect; and
19	WHEREAS, even if enacted, a law may be repealed or waived by a future Congress and President; and
20	WHEREAS, an amendment to the United States Constitution does not require the President's approval
21	and cannot be waived by a future Congress and President.

23	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
24	STATE OF MONTANA:
25	That the Sixty-fifth Legislature urges Congress to propose the Regulation Freedom amendment to the
26	United States Constitution as follows: "Whenever one quarter of the members of the United States House of
27	Representatives or the United States Senate transmits to the President their written declaration of opposition to
28	a proposed federal regulation, it shall require a majority vote of the House of Representatives and the Senate to
29	adopt that regulation."
30	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary of State forward copies of this resolution to each
