Technical Note:

Department of Justice (DOJ)

- Implementation of this bill by the scheduled date would be done by the Motor Vehicle Division (MVD) and other DOJ staff. MVD is currently working on a multi-year project to move driver records off of the state mainframe. Implementation of HB 217 could impact the go-live date for that project. Delaying the go-live date could add up to \$2,000,000 per fiscal year due to mainframe costs.
