**Description of fiscal impact:** HB 477 requires the Office of Public Instruction (OPI) to develop and maintain model school district policies and procedures for firearms safety education, creates a criminal offense "leaving a firearm accessible to a child", establishes a fine of up to \$1,000 for persons convicted of this offense, and requires firearms dealers to display a sign on their premises notifying the public of the new offense. The cost for FY 2020 would be \$25,000 and \$5,000 in FY 2021 and beyond.

### **Assumptions:**

### Office of Public Instruction (OPI)

- 1. HB 477 requires the Office of Public Instruction (OPI) to develop and maintain model school district policies and procedures for firearms safety education.
- 2. The OPI does not have any staff with expertise in the area of firearms safety education. In order to comply with the requirements of the bill for developing and maintaining the policies, the OPI would contract with a company or individual to perform these duties. The cost is estimated at \$25,000 in the first year and \$5,000/yr thereafter.
