<u>Description of fiscal impact:</u> HB 491 establishes a portion of Secondary 569 as the Dr. William J. Norman Memorial Pass. The costs associated with this will be absorbed by the Montana Department of Transportation (MDT).

FISCAL ANALYSIS

Assumptions:

- 1. MDT staff would fabricate and install signs.
- 2. It is assumed that two signs are needed on Secondary 569.
- 3. The cost per sign for labor, material, and installation would be \$671 and can be covered by the Maintenance Division's current budget.
- 4. MDT's Rail, Transit and Planning Division would add this designation to the state tourist map and MDT's route designation map during the regular update cycle.
- 5. The signs will be designed and installed per the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD).
