#### FISCAL ANALYSIS

<u>Description of fiscal impact</u>: This bill will have minimal impact to the Legislative Branch. Costs associated with this legislation will be absorbed within the branch's Program 21 Interim Committees and Activities budget.

### **Assumptions:**

## Legislative Branch

- 1. SB 226 splits the existing Revenue and Transportation Interim Committee into two committees: The Revenue Interim Committee and the Transportation Interim Committee.
- 2. The Revenue Interim Committee will have eight legislative members. The Revenue Interim Committee will have four one-day meetings in Helena and four two-day meetings in Helena for a total of 12 meeting days.
- 3. The Transportation Interim Committee will have eight legislative members. The Transportation Interim Committee will have six one-day meetings in Helena/for a total of six meeting days.
- 4. The current budget for the Revenue and Transportation Interim Committee for the 2021 biennium is \$53,307.
- 5. It is assumed that the additional cost is approximately \$7,000 and could be absorbed within the Program 21 Interim Committees and Activities budget.

6. Costs related to this bill will be included in the base budget request for the 2023 biennium.
