<u>Description of fiscal impact:</u> SB 257 changes the number of members on the Upper Columbia Commission from 9 members to 14 members. The Department of Natural Resources and Conservation (DNRC) is tasked with administering the commission. There will be additional travel costs associated with the added members.

#### FISCAL ANALYSIS

### **Assumptions:**

#### Department of Natural Resources and Conservation (DNRC)

- 1. The DNRC has assumed travel costs per year for the additional five (5) members to be \$1,550 per member per year ( $$1,550 \times 5 = $7,750$ ).
- 2. The additional travel costs will be paid out of the invasive species state special revenue account provided for in 80-7-1004, MCA.
- 3. An inflation factor of 1.5% has been applied to 2022 and 2023.
