11	Section 1. Section 15-30-2641, MCA, is amended to read:
12	"15-30-2641. Penalties for violation of chapter. (1) An individual, corporation, or partnership or an
13	officer or employee of a corporation or member or employer of a partnership who, with intent to evade any tax
14	or requirement of this chapter or any lawful requirement of the department under this chapter, purposely fails to
15	pay the tax or to file or sign any return or to supply information within the time required by this chapter or who with
16	an intent to evade, purposely files or signs a false or fraudulent return or statement or supplies false or fraudulent
17	information is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction must be fined not more than \$1,000 or be imprisoned
18	for not more than 1 year, or both, at the discretion of the court.
19	(2) With respect to the imposition of a civil penalty, evidence produced by the department to the effect
20	that a tax has not been paid, that a return has not been filed, or that information has not been supplied as required
21	under the provisions of this chapter is prima facie evidence that the tax has not been paid, the return has not been
22	filed, or the information has not been supplied."

24	Section 1. Section 15-30-2643, MCA, is amended to read:
25	"15-30-2643. Time limitations for prosecution. A prosecution for an offense under 15-1-216 or
26	15-30-2641 must be commenced within 3 years after the offense is committed."
