9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11	Section 1. Section 20-5-209, MCA, is amended to read:
12	"20-5-209. Bullying of student prohibited criminal penalties. (1) Bullying of a student enrolled in
13	a public K-12 school by another student, a former student, a parent or guardian, or an employee is prohibited.
14	(2) Except as provided in subsection (3), violation of this section is a misdemeanor and is punishable
15	by a fine not to exceed \$500, imprisonment in a county jail or placement in an appropriate youth detention facility
16	for a term not to exceed 1 year, or both.
17	(3) If violation of this section results in the death of or serious bodily injury to the student being bullied,
18	the violation is a felony and is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$10,000, imprisonment for a term not to exceed
19	5 years, or both."
