8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10	Section 1. Section 45-7-205, MCA, is amended to read:
11	"45-7-205. False reports to law enforcement authorities PEACE OFFICERS. (1) A person commits an
12	offense under this section if the person knowingly:
13	(a) gives false information to any law enforcement PEACE officer with the purpose to implicate another;
14	(b) reports to law enforcement authorities A PEACE OFFICER an offense or other incident within their THE
15	OFFICER'S concern knowing that it did not occur; or
16	(c) pretends to furnish law enforcement authorities A PEACE OFFICER with information relating to an
17	offense or incident when the person knows that the person has no information relating to the offense or incident.
18	(2) A person convicted under this section shall MAY SHALL be fined not to exceed \$500 or be imprisoned
19	in the county jail for any term not to exceed 6 months, or both sentenced according to the penalty for the crime
20	that was falsely reported, except a person may not be sentenced to life imprisonment, life imprisonment without
21	the possibility of parole, or death under this section:
22	(A) IF THE CRIME FALSELY REPORTED WAS A MISDEMEANOR, SENTENCED TO NOT MORE THAN 6 MONTHS IN THE
23	COUNTY JAIL OR FINED NOT MORE THAN \$500, OR BOTH; OR
24	(B) IF THE CRIME FALSELY REPORTED WAS A FELONY, SENTENCED TO NOT MORE THAN 404 YEARS IN THE STATE
25	PRISON OR FINED NOT MORE THAN \$10,000, OR BOTH."
