8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10	Section 1. Section 46-5-109, MCA, is amended to read:
11	"46-5-109. Limitations on unmanned aerial vehicles. (1) In any prosecution or proceeding within the
12	state of Montana, information from an unmanned aerial vehicle is not admissible as evidence unless the
13	information was obtained:
14	(a) pursuant to the authority of a search warrant; or
15	(b) in accordance with judicially recognized exceptions to the warrant requirement-; or
16	(c) during the investigation of a motor vehicle accident CRASH SCENE that occurs on or involves a public
17	roadway.
18	(2) Information obtained from the operation of an unmanned aerial vehicle may not be used in an affidavit
19	of probable cause in an effort to obtain a search warrant unless the information was obtained under the
20	circumstances described in subsection (1)(a), or (1)(b), or (1)(c) or was obtained through the monitoring of public
21	lands or international borders.
22	(3) For the purposes of this section, "unmanned aerial vehicle" means an aircraft that is operated without
23	direct human intervention from on or within the aircraft. The term does not include satellites."
