9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11	Section 1. Section 50-37-105, MCA, is amended to read:
12	"50-37-105. Permissible fireworks. Permissible fireworks , excluding sky rockets, roman candles, and
13	bottle rockets, include and are limited to those that meet the definition of "common fireworks" "consumer
14	fireworks" as set forth in the U.S. department of transportation's Hazardous Materials Regulations, 49 CFR, parts
15	173.88 and 173.100, as they read on January 1, 1985, provided in 27 CFR 555.11 and that comply with the
16	construction, chemical composition, and labeling regulations of the U.S. consumer product safety commission,
17	as set forth in 16 CFR, part 1507, as it read on January 1, 1985 parts 1500 and 1507."
