| 18 | fireworks" as set forth in the U.S. department of transportation's Hazardous Materials Regulations, 49 CFR, parts |
| 19 | 173.88 and 173.100, as they read on January 1, 1985, provided in 27 CFR 555.11 and that comply with the |
| 20 | construction, chemical composition, and labeling regulations of the U.S. consumer product safety commission, |
| 21 | as set forth in 16 CFR, part 1507, as it read on January 1, 1985 <u>parts 1500 and 1507</u> ." |
