12	NEW SECTION. Section 1. A	article VIII of The Constitution of the State of Montana is amended by
13	adding a new section 18 that reads:	
14	Section 18. Limitation on state revenue through taxation. (1) The state is prohibited from recognizing	
15	revenue from any tax other than an incor	ne tax, a property tax, or a general statewide sales tax, and no more than
16	two of the three taxes allowed by this section may be imposed at the same time.	
17	(2) The prohibition in this section applies, regardless of whether the state, counties, cities, towns, or an	
18	other local governmental entities collect	or impose a tax from the revenue sources in this section.

20	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Two-thirds vote required. Because [section 1] is a legislative proposal	
21	to amend the constitution, Article XIV, section 8, of the Montana constitution requires an affirmative roll call vote	
22	of two-thirds of all the members of the le	egislature, whether one or more bodies, for passage.

24	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Ef	fective date. If approved by the electorate, [this act] is effective January
25	1, 2022.

27	NEW SECTION. Section 4. Submission to electorate. [This act] shall be submitted to the qualified	
28	electors of Montana at the general election to be held in November 2020 by printing on the ballot the full title of	
29	[this act] and the following:
