9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11	Section 1. Section 87-2-711, MCA, is amended to read:
12	"87-2-711. Class AAAcombination sports license. (1) Except as otherwise provided in this chapter,
13	a resident, as defined by 87-2-102, who is 12 years of age or older or who will turn 12 years old before or during
14	the season for which the license is issued is entitled to:
15	(a) a combination sports license that permits a holder who is 12 years of age or older to exercise all
16	rights granted to holders of Class A, A-1, A-3, and A-5 licenses and resident conservation licenses as prescribed
17	in 87-2-202 upon payment of the sum of \$70 or, if the resident is a service member eligible for a combination
18	sports license pursuant to 87-2-817(2), upon payment of the resident base hunting license fee provided for in
19	87-2-116 [and purchase of the resident aquatic invasive species prevention pass pursuant to 87-2-130]; or
20	(b) a combination sports license that permits a holder who is 12 years of age or older to exercise all
21	rights granted in subsection (1)(a) and the additional rights granted to holders of a Class A-6 tag and a Class E-1
22	license upon payment of the sum of \$85.
23	(2) The department may furnish each holder of a combination sports license an appropriate decal.

26	SECTION 1. SECTION 87-2-523, MCA, IS AMENDED TO READ:
27	"87-2-523. Class E-1resident wolf license. (1) Except as otherwise provided in this chapter and in
28	subsection (2) of this section, a person who is a resident, as defined in 87-2-102, and who is 12 years of age or
29	older or who will turn 12 years old before or during the season for which the license is issued, upon payment of
30	a fee of \$19, may receive a Class E-1 license that entitles a holder who is 12 years of age or older to hunt a wolf

1	and possess the carcass of the wolf as authorized by commission rules.
2	(2) A resident holder of a Class AAA combination sports license, regardless of whether it includes a
3	Class A-6 bear tag, may purchase the first Class E-1 license the person obtains in that license year for \$10.
4	$\frac{(2)}{(3)}$ A person who purchases a license pursuant to this section after August 31 may not use the license
5	until 24 hours after the license is issued.
6	(3)(4) Fees collected pursuant to this section must be deposited and used in accordance with 87-1-623."
