8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10	Section 1. Section 61-9-420, MCA, is amended to read:
11	"61-9-420. Child safety restraint systems standards exemptions. (1) If a child under 6 years of
12	age and weighing less than 60 pounds is a passenger in a motor vehicle, that motor vehicle must be equipped
13	with one child safety restraint restraints appropriate for each child in the vehicle and each child must be properly
14	restrained. The child safety restraint must be appropriate for the height and weight of the child as indicated by
15	manufacturer standards.
16	(2) The department shall by rule establish standards in compliance with 61-9-419 through 61-9-423 and
17	applicable federal standards for approved types of child safety restraint systems.
18	(3) The department may by rule exempt from the requirements of subsection (1) a child who because
19	of a physical or medical condition or body size cannot be placed in a child safety restraint."
