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| 11 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA: |
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| 13 | Section 1. Section 5-12-303, MCA, is amended to read: |
| 14 | "5-12-303. Fiscal analysis information from state agencies. (1) The legislative fiscal analyst may |
| 15 | investigate and examine the costs and revenue of state government activities and may examine and obtain copies |
| 16 | of the records, books, and files of any state agency, including confidential records. |
| 17 | (2) When confidential records and information are obtained from a state agency, the legislative fiscal |
| 18 | analyst and staff must be subject to the same penalties for unauthorized disclosure of the confidential records |
| 19 | and information provided for under the laws administered by the state agency. The legislative fiscal analyst shall |
| 20 | develop policies to prevent the unauthorized disclosure of confidential records and information obtained from |
| 21 | state agencies AND MAY NOT DISCLOSE CONFIDENTIAL RECORDS OR INFORMATION TO LEGISLATORS. |
| 22 | (3) (a) The department of revenue shall make Montana individual income tax information available by |
| 23 | removing names, addresses, and social security numbers and substituting in their place a state accounting record |
| 24 | identifier number. Except for the purposes of complying with federal law, the department may not alter the data |
| 25 | in any other way. |
| 26 | (b) The department of revenue shall provide the name and address of a taxpayer on written request of |
| 27 | the legislative fiscal analyst when the values on the requested return, including estimated payments, are |
| 28 | considered necessary by the legislative fiscal analyst to properly analyze state revenue and are of a sufficient |
| 29 | magnitude to materially affect the analysis and when the identity of the taxpayer is necessary to evaluate the |
| 30 | effect of the return or payments on the analysis being performed. |

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| 1 | (4)(a) The department of public health and human services shall make the following information available |
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| 2 | by removing names, addresses, and social security numbers DIRECT IDENTIFIERS and substituting in their place |
| 3 | <u>a record identifier:</u> |
| 4 | (i) all Montana medicaid and children's health insurance program claims information; |
| 5 | (ii) all public assistance and health care enrollment information; and |
| 6 | (iii) all child and family services division information. |
| 7 | (b) (i) The information must be provided in an electronic format and updated on a monthly basis. |
| 8 | (II) THE PROVISIONS OF SUBSECTION (4)(B)(I) DO NOT APPLY IF: |
| 9 | (A) THE LEGISLATIVE FISCAL ANALYST AGREES IN WRITING THAT THE INFORMATION CAN BE RETRIEVED BY THE |
| 10 | LEGISLATIVE FISCAL ANALYST WITH ALTERNATIVE ACCESS TO THE DEPARTMENT'S DATA SYSTEMS; AND |
| 11 | (B) THE DEPARTMENT AND THE LEGISLATIVE FISCAL ANALYST ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING |
| 12 | TO ALLOW THE LEGISLATIVE FISCAL ANALYST TO ACCESS THE INFORMATION THAT MEETS THE KNOWN DATA NEEDS FOR |
| 13 | <u>LEGISLATIVE ANALYSIS.</u> |
| 14 | (c) For purposes of this subsection (4), the term "direct identifiers" includes the following: |
| 15 | (I) NAMES; |
| 16 | (II) POSTAL ADDRESS INFORMATION, OTHER THAN TOWN OR CITY, STATE, AND ZIP CODE; |
| 17 | (III) TELEPHONE NUMBERS; |
| 18 | (IV) FAX NUMBERS; |
| 19 | (V) ELECTRONIC MAIL ADDRESSES; |
| 20 | (VI) SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBERS; |
| 21 | (VII) MEDICAL RECORD NUMBERS; |
| 22 | (VIII) HEALTH PLAN BENEFICIARY NUMBERS; |
| 23 | (IX) ACCOUNT NUMBERS; |
| 24 | (X) CERTIFICATE AND LICENSE NUMBERS; |
| 25 | (XI) VEHICLE IDENTIFIERS AND SERIAL NUMBERS; |
| 26 | (XII) DEVICE IDENTIFIERS AND SERIAL NUMBERS; |
| 27 | (XIII) INTERNET PROTOCOL ADDRESS NUMBERS; |
| 28 | (XIV) BIOMETRIC IDENTIFIERS, INCLUDING FINGER AND VOICE PRINTS; AND |
| 29 | (XV) FULL FACE PHOTOGRAPHIC IMAGES AND ANY COMPARABLE IMAGES. |
| 30 | (4) (A) THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES SHALL PROVIDE THE LEGISLATIVE FISCAL |

| 3 | (B) THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES SHALL CONSULT WITH THE LEGISLATIVE FISCAL |
| 4 | ANALYST AND SHALL ESTABLISH USER REQUIREMENTS TO ENSURE THE LEGISLATIVE FISCAL ANALYST DOES NOT HAVE |
| 5 | ACCESS TO DIRECT IDENTIFIERS STORED ON THE SECURE DATA WAREHOUSE. THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND |
| 6 | HUMAN SERVICES SHALL CONSULT WITH THE LEGISLATIVE FISCAL ANALYST AND SHALL ESTABLISH REQUIREMENTS TO |
| 7 | ENSURE THE LEGISLATIVE FISCAL ANALYST DOES NOT HAVE ACCESS TO DIRECT IDENTIFIERS STORED IN OTHER DATA |
| 8 | SYSTEMS WHERE THE DATA IS NOT AVAILABLE THROUGH THE SECURE DATA WAREHOUSE AFTER THE PHASES OF THE |
| 9 | SECURE DATA WAREHOUSE PROJECT ARE IMPLEMENTED. |
| 10 | (C) THE DATA MUST BE MADE AVAILABLE TO THE LEGISLATIVE FISCAL ANALYST IN A FORMAT THAT COMPLIES WITH |
| 11 | THE REGULATIONS OF THE RESPECTIVE FEDERAL PROGRAMS. |
| 12 | (D) THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES SHALL SUBMIT QUARTERLY REPORTS IN AN |
| 13 | ELECTRONIC FORMAT TO THE LEGISLATIVE FINANCE COMMITTEE AND THE CHILDREN, FAMILIES, HEALTH, AND HUMAN |
| 14 | SERVICES INTERIM COMMITTEE ON THE FOLLOWING: |
| 15 | (I) THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PHASES OF THE SECURE DATA WAREHOUSE PROJECT; |
| 16 | (II) THE USER REQUIREMENTS ESTABLISHED BY THE DEPARTMENT AND THE LEGISLATIVE FISCAL ANALYST; AND |
| 17 | (III) THE STATUS OF THE LEGISLATIVE FISCAL ANALYST'S ACCESS TO THE SECURE DATA WAREHOUSE. |
| 18 | (4)(5) Within 1 day after the legislative finance committee presents its budget analysis to the legislature, |
| 19 | the budget director and the legislative fiscal analyst shall exchange expenditure and disbursement |
| 20 | recommendations by second-level expenditure detail and by funding sources detailed by accounting entity. This |
| 21 | information must be filed in the respective offices and be made available to the legislature and the public. In |
| 22 | preparing the budget analysis for the next biennium for submission to the legislature, the legislative fiscal analyst |
| 23 | shall use the base budget, the present law base, and new proposals as defined in 17-7-102. |
| 24 | (5)(6) This section does not authorize publication or public disclosure of information if the law prohibits |
| 25 | publication or disclosure or if the department of revenue notifies the fiscal analyst that specified records or |
| 26 | information may contain confidential information." |
