| 10 | election day for polling place elections, an employee must be allowed at least 2 hours of paid leave from |
| 11 | scheduled work hours to vote. The 2 hours of paid leave must be provided at the convenience of the employer |
| 12 | but in consideration of time the employee will reasonably need to travel to the polling location. |
| 13 | (2) Subsection (1) is not applicable: |
| 14 | (a) on the state general election day designated as a holiday under 1-1-216 if the employee is already |
| 15 | receiving paid leave; or |
| 16 | (b) if the employee is scheduled to work fewer than half of the hours during which polls are open under |
| 17 | 13-1-106. |
| 18 | (3) For purposes of this section, "employee" has the meaning provided for in 39-3-201. |
