11	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

13	Section 1. Section 18-3-101, MCA, is amended to read:
14	"18-3-101. Authority to lease with option to purchase. (1) When Except as provided in subsection
15	(2), when authorized by a vote of two-thirds of the members of each house of the legislature, the department of
16	administration may, as part of the long-range building program, enter into a lease contract that provides an option
17	to purchase a building to be used by the state or any department of state government.
18	(2) A vote of two-thirds of the members of each house of the legislature and inclusion in the long-range
19	building program is not required for a lease contract that provides an option to purchase if the building will be
20	used for colocated laboratory space that will include facilities that conduct animal health testing for pathogens
21	that could impact public health."
